The Steering Committee guides the MBAR Committee's efforts, ensuring alignment with the A.A. Twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions, and Twelve Concepts.

Positions include:

- Chairperson
- Co-Chairperson
- Recording Secretary
- Treasurer

Qualifications to Serve - Candidates must:

- Actively work the Twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions, and Twelve Concepts of A.A.
- Have at least one year of sobriety.
- Have prior experience serving on an MBAR Committee.
- Be willing to attend both Steering and Regular Committee meetings.

Election Process:

- Nominations: Made from the floor at the election meeting.
- Voting: Conducted by a show of hands, tallied by the Recording Secretary.
- Eligibility: Nominees must be present to accept nominations.

Key Responsibilities:

- Uphold A.A. principles and MBAR policies.
- Safeguard MBAR funds.
- Facilitate communication among members.
- Attend monthly Steering Committee meetings.

Term Details:

- Term Length: Two years (or until the year following the conference).
- Members may not serve consecutive terms in the same position.
